

BY-LAWS AMENDMENT

Article VI, Sec. 2, Paragraph B to be amended as follows: eliminate the following sentence in Sec. B

The pastor shall have in charge the welfare and oversight of the church; he shall.....

This article will be amended and inserted in Article XII, AMENDMENTS, Sec. 3 Paragraph A.

Article VI, Sec. 2, Paragraph B shall read as follows: The pastor shall be ex-officio member of all organizations, departments and committees; he may call a special meeting of the deacons or of any committee according to procedures which are set forth in the by-laws; he shall conduct religious services on stated and on special occasions, administer the ordinances, minister to the spiritual needs of the members of the church and community; he shall perform other duties that usually pertain to that office; he shall have special charge of the pulpit ministry of the church and shall be in charge of all worship services, including funerals, weddings, or other special services held at the church; and shall, in cooperation with the deacons provide for pulpit supply when he is absent and shall arrange, with the concurrence of the deacons, for ministers to assist in revival meetings and workers to assist in other special services required by the church. It shall be his special responsibility to win the lost to Christ; to minister to the spiritual needs of the members of his congregation, and through prayer and study to render effective preaching and pastoral ministries.
