

RULES FOR USING FELLOWSHIP HALL

We must recognize that this building is as much a part of the complete church as the Sanctuary and Educational Building: therefore,

1. There will be no smoking or playing of non-christian music.
 2. Any organization within the church may use the building for church oriented meetings including meals.
 3. The building must be left after meetings clean.
 4. There will be no use of building while a service is in progress.
 5. There will be no cooking in building with any kind of portable cookers. All cooking will be done on stoves in kitchen.
 6. Building will be available for marriage receptions of weddings held at BRBC.
 7. Building will be available for anniversaries such as twenty-fifth or fiftieth for church members only.
 8. No family reunions or other family meetings or meals. These are to remain at the community building.

FELLOWSHIP HALL RULES

1. COUNTER TOPS IN KITCHEN FELLOWSHIP ARE TO BE LEFT CLEAN WITH NOTHING LEFT OUT ON THEM. (NO OPENED BOTTLED DRINKS OR FOOD SHOULD BE LEFT OUT, PLEASE DISPOSE OF THEM). UNOPENED DRINKS CAN BE STORED IN CABINETS OR KITCHEN STORAGE ROOM. UNUSED COOKIES, ETC. USED FOR CHILDREN'S CHURCH AND CHOIR SUPPERS SHOULD BE STORED IN SEALED CONTAINERS AND PUT AWAY IN CABINETS.
2. MAKE SURE TRASH LINER IS IN KITCHEN TRASH CAN BEFORE USING. IF PERISHABLE FOOD IS PUT IN TRASH , PLEASE REMOVE BEFORE LEAVING. IT IS RESPONSIBILITY OF INDIVIDUAL OR ORGANIZATION USING KITCHEN FELLOWSHIP TO REMOVE TRASH FROMM KITCHEN.
3. LEAVE NOTHING IN REFRIGERATORS. (THIS MEANS BREAD, MEAT, ROLLS OR ANY PERISHABLE ITEMS.)
4. NO DIRTY DISHES OR SILVERWARE ARE TO BE LEFT IN KITCHEN SINK.
